KNOW YOU BY THESE PRESENTS:


WHEREAS, eighteen statewide conservation organizations have established the Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame in Stevens Point; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Hall of Fame is to recognize outstanding leadership in environmental protection and serve as an educational facility; and


WHEREAS, our great state has long been at the forefront of new ideas and innovative technology concerning the conservation of our natural resources; and
