

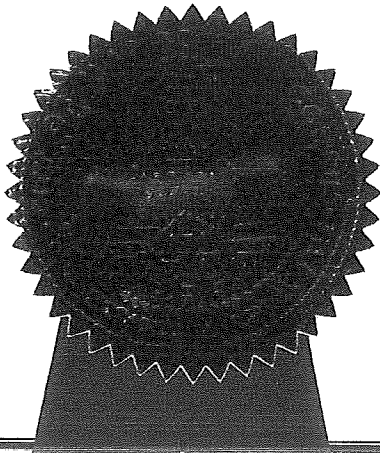
MAYORAL PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS,** Harold "Bud" Jordahl is Emeritus Professor in the Department of Urban and Regional Planning at the University of Wisconsin-Madison; and
- WHEREAS,** Bud also served as a member and chair of the Wisconsin Natural Resources Board; and
- WHEREAS,** Bud has had a long and distinguished career in the field of land use planning and throughout his career has been involved in a number of large and important land use projects, including the St. Croix National Scenic Riverway and the Wisconsin River preservation project; and
- WHEREAS,** Bud was an early adviser on environmental issues to then Governor Gaylord Nelson, contributing ideas that formed the beginning of the modern environmental movement; and
- WHEREAS,** Bud is a true steward of the land and someone who lives the spirit of Aldo Leopold's land ethic; and
- WHEREAS,** like Aldo Leopold, Bud has been a long-term resident of Madison's west side, and like Leopold, he has lovingly restored a Wisconsin farm to ecological health; and
- WHEREAS,** the current Mayor of Madison has had the privilege of being a part of the Jordahl Deer Camp since 1992 and has enjoyed hearing many fine stories (some more than once), playing many hands of Sheephead, eating many venison dinners, and seeing (if not actually shooting) many deer; and
- WHEREAS,** the Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame Foundation recognizes individuals who have contributed significantly to the growth of the conservation ideal in Wisconsin and the Nation and who have made a sustained and outstanding contribution to conservation in applied resource management, environmental law enforcement, conservation literature, art, or journalism; and
- WHEREAS,** Bud Jordahl will be inducted into the Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame on Saturday, April 9, 2005, at the 21st annual Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame ceremony in Stevens Point;
