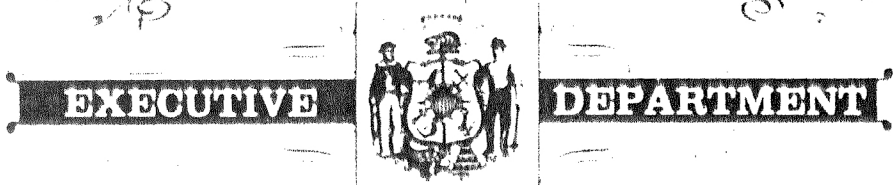


# The State of Wisconsin


### "MULLY" TAYLOR DAY
