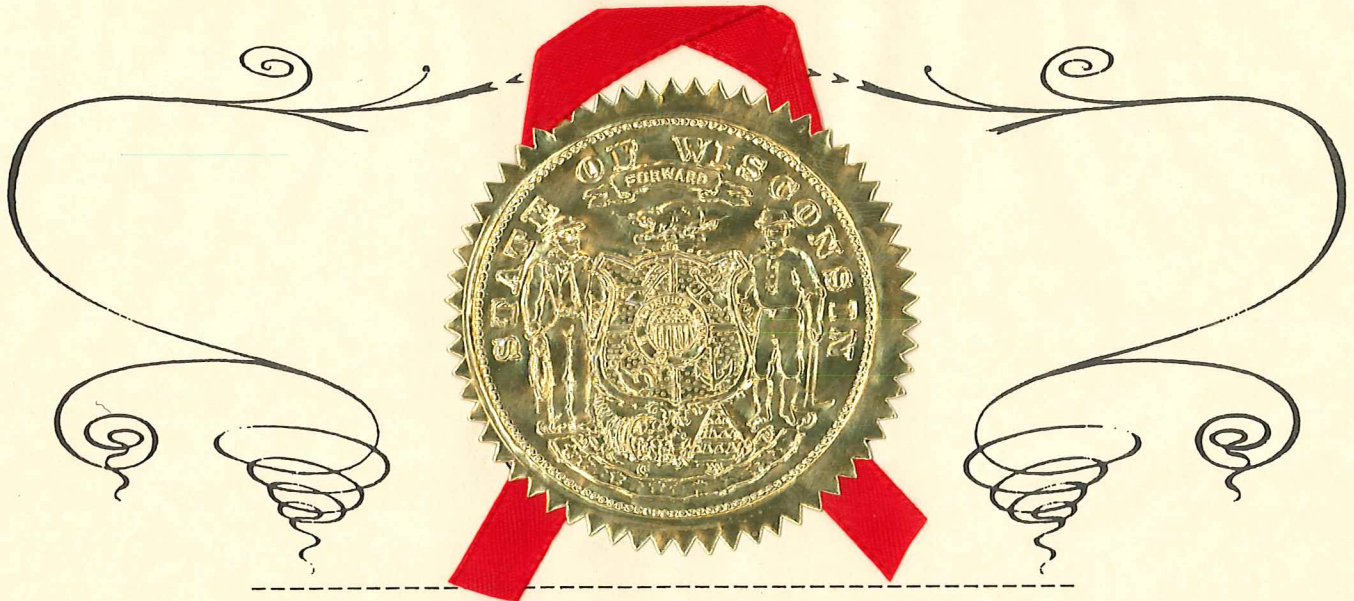


WHEREAS, he defined and confirmed public rights in state rivers and streams from the Muench vs. Public Service Commission decision in 1951; and
