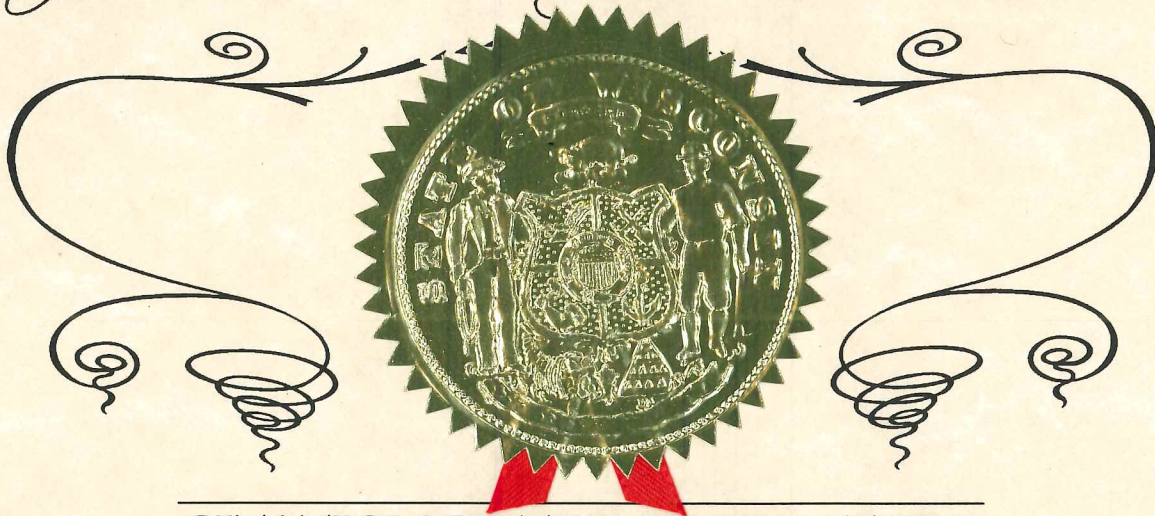

CITATION BY THE LEGISLATURE

KNOW YOU BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, Haskell Noyes, a prominent conservationist of enduring accomplishments, will be inducted into the Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, upon his return from service in World War I, Noyes became deeply involved in conservation efforts that spread across local, state, and national levels; and


WHEREAS, Haskell Noyes, a successful business leader, helped found both the Milwaukee chapter and Wisconsin division of the Izaak Walton league where he served as its president and lifelong member; and

WHEREAS, through his service on the Conservation Commission, Noyes helped create the basic Conservation Act, the Forest Crop law, forest protection areas, and a Water Pollution Control Committee; and


WHEREAS, Haskell Noyes led efforts to promote state forestry practices and proved instrumental in securing land for the Kettle Moraine State Forest; and

WHEREAS, Haskell Noyes enthusiastically commemorated the role of conservation wardens by establishing an award to honor their profession; now


