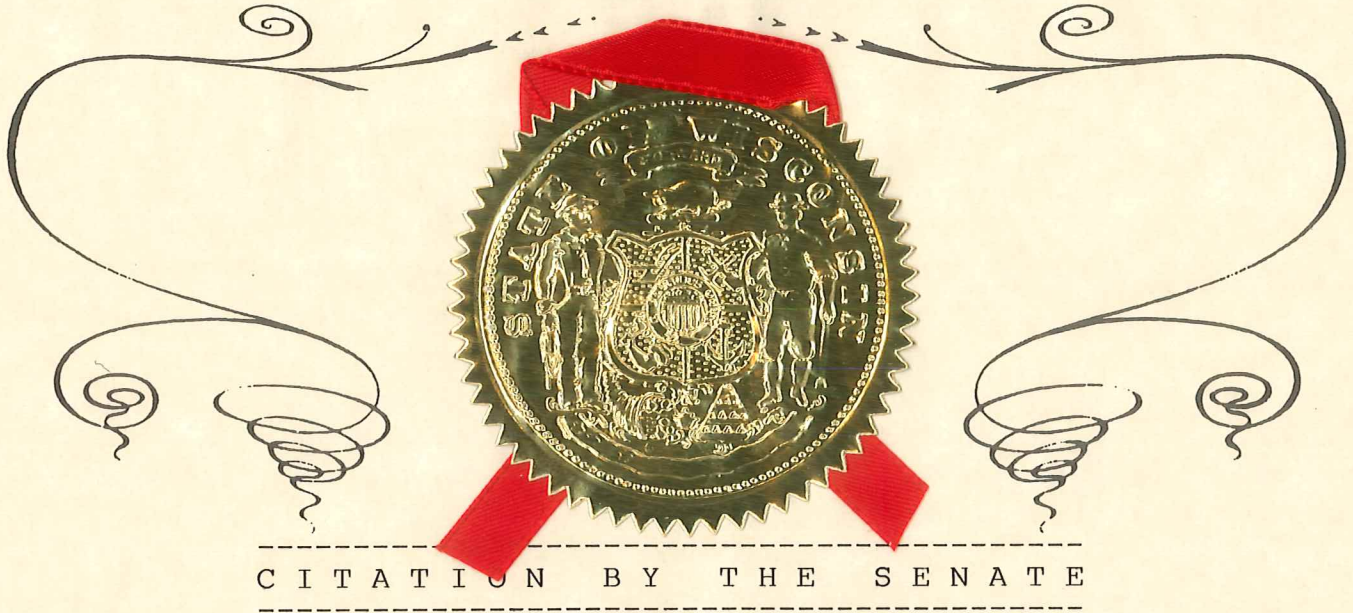


THE STATE OF WISCONSIN


WHEREAS, he was elected first president of WFCC in 1949, and was its former executive director; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Les Woerpel is being inducted into the 1990 Conservation Hall of Fame; now


