KNOW YOU BY THESE PRESENTS:


WHEREAS, Raymond T. Zillmer was a lifelong proponent of conservation in Wisconsin; and


WHEREAS, from Raymond Zillmer's ideas came the Ice Age National Scientific Reserve and soon the Ice Age Trail will become a reality; now
