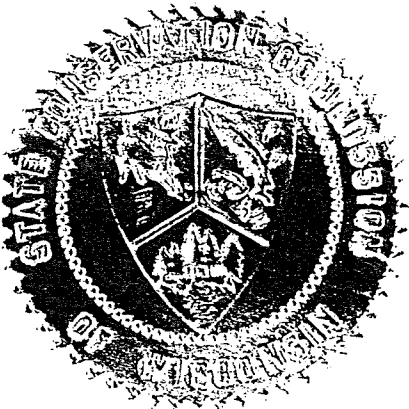
for a contribution toward the encouragement and support of the Wisconsin conservation program. This is the fifth such gift in recent years totaling \$25,000 to date.
